"You have lung cancer stage 4. Your left line has a mass and survival chance is 20%." This news came from my chemo oncologist 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> months ago.

Eleven (11) months ago I went to my physical therapist for spinal stretching and exercise. She has been manipulating my spine for a few years. I have been going to physical therapy since I had lower back surgery five years ago. Lisa mentioned swelling in my back that should not be there. She thought it might have been a blockage to my heart and suggested I see a cardiologist.

I made an appointment with Dr. Chaplik who has since retired. He wondered why she suspected any problems but decided to go with the xray of my heart. He stated that I am healthy but x-rayed my heart due to my insistence. In the x-ray the doctor noticed a tumor in my left lung

This started my adventure for the past several months. The cardiologist sent me to a pulmonologist who sent me for a CAT scan and found the tumor in my left lung. He then recommended me to my lead oncologist and my radiology oncologist. The two doctors decided along with the pulmonologist to give me enough treatment for cure rather than just sustain where I was. I was fine with that. Bill and I continued our adventure going back and forth to the oncologist for chemotherapy and radiation therapy.

Along with my medical doctors I have been seen therapist for my mental health again for several years. Bruce EIMER, PhD introduced me again to hypnotherapy. I have had this in the past and I have been hypnotized very easily. He worked on the mind in a positive manner and assured my unconscious that I would survive the cancer that was eating my body. We worked on positive visualizations and auditory stimuli. This kept me thinking positive and without pain throughout my cancer treatments.

Bill has been a rock in my recovery and took me to all my treatments. My family and friends have been incredibly supportive throughout this adventure. I have lots of people who have prayed along with my children and their friends. We cannot receive too much positive or too many prayers in our lives. I am blessed to have all these support people along with the medical doctors who have been amazing. The doctors worked the medical part; and my therapists, friends and family have worked along with them to bring me to this day. Last Monday, April 17 I went in for a PET scan. On Wednesday, April 19 my chemo Dr. told me that I was cancer free. Thank you to everyone who knows me has prayed for me and wished me all the positive energy around. I am blessed.


