The Cane Toad (a.k.a. Bufo frog)



If you have a Pet, *please* read this!

Cane toads have become a *significant* concern for pet owners in South Florida due to their toxicity. These toads secrete a potent venom that can be fatal to dogs and cats. Pets come into contact with the venom by playing with or biting the toads. This can lead to severe health issues, and some cases, even death. Symptoms of Cane Toad poisoning in pets can include: excessive salivation, pawing at the mouth, shaking head side to side, vomiting, rapid or irregular heartbeats, seizures, loss of coordination, paralysis, and coma. If you suspect has come into contact with a Cane Toad, it is crucial to seek *immediate* veterinary attention. Time is of the essence, as the venom can quickly lead to severe consequences. Precautions:

Keep your yard and outdoor spaces free of standing water, which can attract Cane Toads. Supervise your pets,, especially during outdoor activities to prevent them from coming into contact with Cane Toads.



(see below recipe), and potato latkes (pancakes). For desert we have sufganiyot (jelly donuts) as a reminder that life can be sweet.

My mother's brisket recipe

Preheat oven to 350 degrees 3 – 4 lbs of brisket (first cut). Sprinkle brisket with garlic salt. Sprinkle brisket with Lipton Onion Soup Mix Add 1 glass of water Cover with foil tightly Cook for 3 ¹⁄₂ - 4 hours.

CANNOLI DIP





An easy cannoli dip (that doesn't taste like cream cheese!), mixed with delicious mini chocolate chips, and served with broken waffle cones or broken Pizzelle cookies for dipping.

INGREDIENTS

- 1-1/2 cups ricotta
- 8 oz. cream cheese room temperature
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1/3 cup mini chocolate chips
- waffle cones or Pizzelle cookies broken
 Use a stand mixer (or hand mixer)
- Add in ricotta, cream cheese and powdered sugar.
- Mix on medium/high speed until smooth,
 3-5 mins.
- Add in vanilla extract and whip for 30 seconds.

Taste test, add more powder sugar if needed about 2 tablespoons at a time. You can safely add up to another 1/2 cup of powdered sugar (8 tablespoons) without negatively impacting consistency.

Fold in mini chocolate chips, reserving some to sprinkle on top for decoration, if desired. Serve dip immediately with broken waffle cones or broken Pizzelle cookies for dipping.

Icing Ingredients 1 box confectioner sugar 1 stick butter, softened 8 ounces cream cheese, softened 1 tsps. Vanilla extract 1 cup pecan pieces

To prepare cake: use electric mixer and mix sugar, oil and eggs till smooth. Sift together flour, soda and cinnamon. Mix the dry ingredients with the first mixture a little bit at a time, until blended. Stir in grated carrots. Pour into 3 lightly greased and floured 9" pans. Bake at 350 for approx. 25 mins. till done.

To prepare icing: Use electric mixer to cream butter & cream cheese. Slowly add the sugar till blended. Stir in vanilla and fold in nuts. Ice cake when cake is cool. Keep refrigerated. May be frozen.

The Therapist's Couch

I am a NYC Psychotherapist in private practice who has relocated to Delray Beach. In the course of my work, I offer many simple and practical tips for maintaining good mental wellness to my clients, which I use in my own life to feel better. I wish to share some here with you. When something is weighing heavily on my mind, or I get stuck on repetitive thoughts or worries that I just cannot shake, there are a few methods that I use to clear my head. First, I imagine a big box in front of me. I then visualize putting all of the intrusive thoughts into the box, making sure to capture them all. Next, I take an imaginary ribbon or string and tie up the box, nice and tight, wrapping the string in both directions. I then tie a tight knot or bow. After that, I imagine tying a big helium balloon to the box. Once attached, I watch the box taking off, floating up into the sky. I watch it fly higher and higher, until... it is out of sight. I then tune-in and let myself feel the release, and the calm. After that, I turn my attention to something else (e.g. take a shower, go for a walk, call a friend, watch a movie, etc.). Anytime the intrusive thoughts try to creep back-in, I "thank them for sharing," and remind them that I am not thinking about them right now, over and over again. As an alternative to this, once I have imagined the thoughts wrapped tightly in the box, I take the box and place it on a high shelf in my closet. With this method, I know that I can take down the box at anytime that I wish to deal with those thoughts again, but on my terms. Another technique that I use, especially when I cannot sleep at night because things are on my mind, is writing down all the thoughts and feelings on a piece of paper, or electronic device. In this way, it is off my mind, so I have cleared my head for sleep. Also, in the off-chance that I might forget it by the morning, it is already written down to deal with in the light of day. This method also works when needing to have a difficult conversation with someone who you will see in the future. Writing down your thoughts and feelings not only helps you organize your thoughts, but helps reassure you that you will remember what you wanted to say. You can also add to it, or modify it over time, as well. There have been times where just the act of writing it down has satisfied my need to handle the issue in question, to the point that I no longer need to confront that person. I have also found that by the time I am ready to talk to the person, my view of what happened has shifted and I no longer need to speak up, because writing it down has helped me see it in a new light. A last technique that I use when I find myself obsessing over something, is that I designate a certain time of day, that I will allow myself to intensely think about "the thing." So for example, everyday from 10-10:30am I give myself permission to think about the issue. When the time is up I then cannot think about the issue until the next day at the designated time. These methods are an attempt to contain intrusive thoughts, in an effort to better maintain peace of mind. I hope you will try the one that resonates you most first, and then try the rest. Then place them into your imaginary "Wellness Toolbox" which you can take out at anytime.
